St. Petersburg is the European "gate" of Russia, its strategic center directly bordering the countries of the European Union.

St. Petersburg is the second largest university center in Russia. There are over 90 institutions of higher education and over 350 research organisations here.

SPbU LANGUAGE TESTING CENTER

St. Petersburg University Language Testing Center was established on August 22 1997 for the purpose of administering the Test of Russian as a Foreign Language (TORFL). SPbU has, over the 20 years of its existence, gained a reputation as one of the leaders in the field of testing foreign citizens.

The Ministry of Education and Science of the Russian Federation included St. Petersburg University to the list of educational institutions entitled to conduct the test of Russian language as a foreign language (TORFL) and authorized to issue a certificate of national standard required to study at a Russian higher education institution.

- The First Certification Level (TORFL-I/B1) is required for admission to degree programs at Russian universities.
- The Second Certification Level (TORFL-II/B2) is
 required for a Bachelor's or/and a Master's degree
 program at Russian universities.
- ▼ The Third Certification Level (TORFL-III/C1) is required for admission to PhD programs at Russian universities.

150 University distinguished language instructors teach international students Russian as a foreign language, many of them are authors of their own teaching methods and study guides. RUSSIAN AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE. GENERAL COURSE

- The course is designed for all entry levelsof Russian
- It is built on a module structure
- Each module finishes with diagnosis test

This course is addressed to foreign high school graduates, university and college students and other foreign citizens. It helps them to master their Russian, to feel confidence in everyday communication, to broaden knowledge in Russian culture.

RUSSIAN AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE. SHORT TERM COURSE

- The course is addressed to foreign trainees with the minimum level of Russian A2.
- The main goal of this course is to help students to improve their communicative competence in speaking and listening.
- All courses are taught in groups with maximum 15 students in a group.
- Teaching is from Monday till Friday.
