Instructions for lecturers on selecting and integrating e-learning resources

Dear colleagues!

At present, you can already integrate into your course the e-learning resources developed by St Petersburg University and hosted on the Open edX platform.

As for the online courses hosted on the <u>Coursera</u> platform, we can inform you that authorisation procedures for free access to the platform's resources are being tested. The platform is currently processing applications from universities for participation in the <u>Coursera</u> for <u>Campus Initiative</u> programme in response to the coronavirus.

The Coursera Blog reports that a series of training webinars will be held shortly to explain how this educational initiative will be implemented. The page dedicated to the Coursera Response Initiative clarifies that the platform will process the requests in an order of priority that accounts for the level of impact the university is experiencing because of the virus.

In response to an enquiry, we have received a message from our partners that it takes from 2 to 10 working days to process and prepare for implementing the system. This depends on the authorisation service configuration.
